Thank you for your entry for this event.

Your Signing-on declaration is now live and must be completed (complete and submit one form for driver and one form for navigator) via <u>www.namcc.com</u>. Your competition number can be found on the Entry List on <u>www.namcc.com</u> - VIRTUAL NOTICEBOARD also on the Rallyscore website.

# \*ALL COMPETITORS USING BLUEFIN ROAD TRAFFIC INSURANCE MUST HAVE THEIR DECLARATION COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED BY 10.00pm on TUESDAY 28<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2022.

# ALL COMPETITORS MUST HAVE ELECTRONIC SIGN-ON COMPLETED BY 10.00PM on WEDNESDAY 29<sup>th</sup> JULY.

To those competitors who had not entered any seeding information on the original entry form, no discussions on seeding will be entered into. The Start time list will be issued on the day along with Final Instruction 2.

**Loughgall Country Park entrance/exit**. Follow the stage type arrows at main entrance to the Country Park, in Loughgall Main Street and then the marshals' instructions for parking within the Country Park Service area. If you follow their instructions there will be plenty of room for everyone. Note: Large/heavy service vehicles **must not park** on the large grass pitch area, they will instead be parked on either of the two other hard surfaced service areas.

**Scrutineering checks and noise testing** for all will be held in Loughgall Country Park from 4.00pm until 8.30pm on Friday 1<sup>st</sup>July 2022 and again for those few competitors not leaving their rally car and service vehicle overnight at Loughgall Country Park (and have been given approval not to do so by organisers), on Saturday 2nd July 2022 between 7.30am and 8.45am. The Scrutineers will require to see portable safety equipment which should be displayed outside of the car and also competitors should have their vehicle bonnet in open position. Please note: <u>only</u> competing vehicles and service vehicles will be allowed access to the service areas.

# NOTE: Vehicles, whether competing or service, arriving AFTER 08:30 hrs on Saturday will NOT gain entry to the Service Area.

### \*\*MOT & Vehicle Tax will be required (and may be checked).

NOTE: Loughgall Country Park will close the gates at 9.30pm on Friday 1st July and professional security will be on duty throughout the night to safeguard competitors' cars, service vehicles and equipment generally. Unless staying overnight you must be out of the park by then.

### **Noise Testing:**

All competing cars and Course '0' Cars at each event are to be noise tested under sections R.4.1 & J5.18 of the Motorsport UK 2022 Regulations Yearbook. This is a mandatory Motorsport UK requirement for all rallies. This will be carried out in Loughgall Country Park in the general area used for service. **The Motorsport UK limit for the noise test is 100 decibels.**

## RALLY ROUTE IS DEFINED BY "TULIP" TYPE ROAD BOOK AND IN ADDITION FOR INFORMATION, THE SPECIAL STAGES WILL BE SHOWN ON SEPARATE SPECIAL STAGE MAPS.

## ROAD BOOKS WILL BE AVAILABLE ALONG WITH RALLY PLATES AND DECALS, AT THE SERVICE ENTRY CONTROL, ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON AT SCRUTINY).

### EVENT ORGANISERS TIMING RECORDS AND CHECKSHEETS WILL BE TAKEN AS FINAL.

#### START AND STAGE FINISH PROCEDURE

Full details of event timing procedures will be contained in Final Instruction 2.

### SPILL KITS

Spill kits MUST be carried by all competing cars during the rally and if used they must be placed in the bag provided and taken to your local recycling centre for disposal.

#### SAFETY NOTES

Safety notes **are** permitted on this event. The organisers have appointed Patterson Agency Limited to provide competitors with safety notes/video; contact sales@rallynews.net or tel: 028 908 4411. Only the organisers Special Stage maps may be used.

### RECONNAISSANCE

In accordance with regulations, you will be permitted to make a reconnaissance of the stages on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July from 16.00hrs until 20.30hrs and again on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> July between

07:30 hrs & 08:45 hrs. (when you must be off the stage). Competitors may recce ONLY ON FOOT OR PEDAL CYCLE between these times. NO MOTORISED TRANSPORT WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE STAGES AT THESE TIMES.

#### NO PERSON WILL BE PERMITTED TO USE ANY FORM OF MOTORISED OR PEDAL TRANSPORT IN OR AROUND THE SERVICE AREA AFTER 09.00hrs, THIS PARTICULARY APPLIES TO CHILDREN.

If any person ignoring this instruction is connected to a competitor, he/she will BE EXCLUDED. THIS IS FOR EVERYBODYS SAFETY AND WILL BE ENFORCED.

### TYRE WARMING/DRIVING STANDARDS

On way from the Service Area to the Stage Start, any irresponsible driving including doughnuts, circles or U-turns will not be tolerated. A judge of fact will be appointed to monitor the use of tyre heating devices. Tyre temperatures may be monitored throughout the event. Should the Clerk of the course suspect any competitor to be in breach of this regulation the competitor will be penalised as per SR21.28. The Clerk of the Course's decision will be final.

We would also remind all competitors of Motorsport UK regulation J 5.13.7 where all cars must be equipped with the facility to enable a fuel sample to be taken. For fuel injected cars the facility must be a dry break fuel sampling coupling approved by the FIA.

Finally, if for whatever reason, you find you will not be able to compete, please inform the Entries Secretary (Barry Taggart, 07771 892423) prior to 12 noon on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July, so that a reserve crew can be notified.
